The word 'Transformation' as it means, 'the state of being transformed' had inspired me to explore into the new direction. At a time when I tried to break away from a norm, it was just a good idea to get along with. Changing the mode of the work, I felt it would be better to change the medium as well. I decided to use pastels. The reason for that was I wasn't familiar with the medium. To use it was a kind of challenge.
